

Gift Wrap With Style



Make your gifts unforgettable using our beautiful papers as gift-wraps. Embellished with glittering gold Boda or Rubber Tree Leaves, “ribbons” cut from coordinating papers, and your sense of style, assures that your gift will be even more special.

Materials Needed:

- Decorative Papers
- Scissors
- Double-Sided Tape
- Craft Knife
- Metal Ruler
- Thin Wire
- Glue Stick



For the Blue Wrap, we used a sheet of Thai Confetti Royale Blue and a sheet of Thai Metallic Gold. We made a paper “ribbon” by cutting 2” strips from the long edge of Thai Metallic Gold paper, and 1” strips from the Confetti Royale Blue. The Gold was attached to the Blue, allowing for ½” on either side, using double-sided tape. The finished “ribbon” was attached to the length and width (overlapping slightly to join) with pieces of double-sided tape. Two Gold Boda Leaves were used for final embellishment, again using small pieces of double-sided tape to hold in place.

For the Black Stripe Wrap, we used a sheet of Thai Indian Woodblock Black/Gold Stripe, a sheet of Thai Unryu Black, and gold Rubber Leaves. We tore the Black Unryu into five separate flower petals slightly larger than the Rubber Leaves, and attached the Rubber Leaves close to the bottom of each petal with a small piece of double-stick tape. These were then arranged on the wrapped box, again using double-stick tape. A circle cut out of the Black and Gold Stripe, attached with double-stick tape, ties the design together.

For the Pink Wrap, we used a sheet of Thai Splatter Pink and a sheet of Thai Gold Momi. We cut 1 ½” strips from the Gold Momi’s long side to make a “ribbon” and 10 separate 3” flower petal shapes. Then we cut ½” strips from the Splatter Pink’s long side for center of the “ribbon”, and 5 slender 2 ½” petal shapes. The “ribbon” strips were put together using the double-stick tape and wrapped around the package. We cut five 6” pieces of thin wire and attached the wire to the back of 5 of the Gold Momi petals with double stick tape, leaving 3” of the wire exposed. Using a glue stick, the other 5 Gold Momi petals were glued to the other side to cover the wire, and to attach the slender Splatter Pink petal shapes on top of the Gold Momi petals. The exposed wires were twisted together with plastic tape, and the flower was shaped and attached to the box with double stick tape behind the “ribbon”. We glued a few pink beads in the center of the flower to complete the look.
